RULES AND REGULATIONS:

To be eligible for the Holmes-Wayne Electric Scholarship Awards, the following provisions will govern the acceptance of applications:

- 1. Applicants must be sons, daughters, or legal wards of Holmes-Wayne Electric Cooperative, Inc. residential members, living on the lines and receiving service at the time of competition.
- **2.**Applicants cannot be immediate family members of or reside with individual employed by HWEC.
- **3.**Applicants must be graduating high school seniors who have all basic credits for college, or proper vocational, or technical school entrance. (*Proper vocational or technical schools* is defined as post-secondary institutions where credits can be transferred to state-accredited four-year colleges.)
- 4. Applicants must have a current career average of 3.6 or above on a 4.0 scale, or equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale.
- 5.Applications for the local Holmes-Wayne Electric Cooperative, Inc. competition must be submitted (typed to be accepted) on the forms provided by HWEC. Application forms must be returned to the coop office by Friday, January 26, 2024. Application information must be confined to the official form. The only attachments permitted are: transcript, teacher recommendations, and one photo of the applicant. (Teacher recommendations shall not exceed 500-words.)
- 6. Applicants who have received "full ride" scholarships (tuition, room, board, *and* books) to the schools of their choice are not eligible.
- 7. Personal interviews will be conducted with qualified applicants.
